





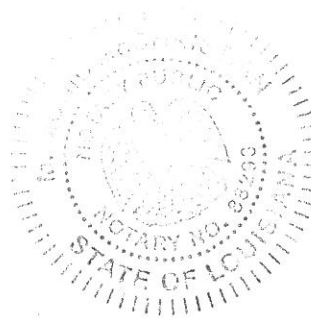

In accordance with La. R.S. 38:3097.3, the Commissioner of Conservation will hold a public hearing on Thursday, April 12, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. in the LaBelle Room, 1st Floor of the LaSalle Building located at 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana to take testimony, receive evidence and hear public comments in order to determine if the water table under East Baton Rouge Parish is being lowered because of excessive pumping of groundwater, and whether the lowering of the water table is causing the acceleration of the intrusion of salt water in the "1500" and "2000" foot sands of the Southern Hills aquifer system from south of the Baton Rouge Fault into the fresh water north of the Baton Rouge Fault.

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All interested persons will be afforded an opportunity to present data, views or arguments, orally or in writing, at said public hearing. Written comments should be directed to:

The following resolution was offered by David Cornette and seconded by Milton Coates.

"Owner@ or AOwners" means the Person reflected as registered owner of any of the Bonds on the registration books maintained by the Paying Agent.

"Paying Agent" means IBERIABANK, in the City of Lafayette, Louisiana, as paying agent and registrar hereunder, until a successor Paying Agent shall have become such pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Resolution, and thereafter APaying Agent@ means such successor Paying Agent.

"Person" means any individual, corporation, partnership, joint venture, association, joint-stock company, trust, unincorporated organization, or government or any agency or political subdivision thereof.

"Purchaser" means IBERIABANK, in the City of Lafayette, Louisiana.

"Record Date" means, with respect to an Interest Payment Date, the fifteenth day of the calendar month next preceding such Interest Payment Date, whether or not such day is a Business Day.

"Refunded Bonds" means the outstanding General Obligation School Bonds, Series 2002, of the Issuer falling due on March 1 of the years 2013 through 2017.

"Resolution" means this resolution, as it may be amended and supplemented as herein provided.

"State" means the State of Louisiana.

**ARTICLE
AUTHORIZATION AND ISSUANCE OF BONDS**

SECTION Authorization of Bonds: Refunding of Refunded Bond. This Resolution creates a series of Bonds of the Issuer designated AGeneral Obligation School Refunding Bonds, Series 2012, of Consolidated School District No. 1 of the Parish of West Feliciana, State of Louisiana@ and provides for the full and final payment of the principal and interest on all the Bonds.

The Bonds issued under this Resolution shall be issued for the purpose of refunding the Refunded Bonds and paying the Costs of Issuance.

Provision having been made for the orderly payment until earlier redemption of the Refunded Bonds in accordance with their terms, it is hereby recognized and acknowledged that as of the date of delivery of the Bonds under this Resolution, provision will have been made for the performance of all covenants and agreements of the Issuer incidental to the Refunded Bonds, and that accordingly, and in compliance with all that is herein provided, the Issuer is expected to have no future obligation with reference to the Refunded Bonds, except to assure that the Refunded Bonds is paid from proceeds of the Bonds as hereinafter set forth.

SECTION Resolution to Constitute Contract. The provisions of this Resolution shall be a contract of the Issuer with the Owner and shall be deemed to be and shall constitute a contract between the Issuer and the Owner from time to time of the Bonds.

SECTION Obligation of Bonds. The Bonds shall constitute general obligations of the Issuer, and the full faith and credit of the Issuer is hereby pledged for their payment and for the payment of all the interest thereon. The Issuer is bound under the terms and provisions of law and this Resolution to impose and collect annually, in excess of all other taxes, a tax on all the property subject to taxation within the territorial limits of the Issuer, sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds falling due each year, said tax to be levied and collected by the same officers in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes are levied and collected within the territorial limits of the Issuer. All ad valorem taxes levied by the Issuer in each year for the payment of the Bonds shall, upon their receipt, be transferred to this Governing Authority, which shall have responsibility for the deposit of such receipts and for the investment and reinvestment of such receipts and the servicing of the Bonds and any other general obligation bonds of the Issuer.

SECTION Authorization and Designation. Pursuant to the provisions of the Act and other constitutional and statutory authority, there is hereby au-

in Section 2.3 hereof and no other moneys whatsoever (except for interest earnings thereon). The depository for the Sinking Fund shall transfer from the Sinking Fund to the Paying Agent at least three (3) days in advance of each Interest Payment Date, funds fully sufficient to pay promptly the principal and interest falling due on such date.

All moneys deposited with the regularly designated fiscal agent bank or banks of the Issuer or the Paying Agent under the terms of this Resolution shall constitute sacred funds for the benefit of the Owners and shall be secured by said fiduciaries at all times to the full extent thereof in the manner required by law for the securing of deposits of public funds.

All or any part of the moneys in the Sinking Fund shall, at the written request of the Issuer, be invested in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State in which event all income derived from such investments shall be added only to the Sinking Fund.

SECTION Payment of Bonds. The Issuer shall duly and punctually pay or cause to be paid as herein provided the principal of and interest on the Bonds as the same fall due and at the place and in the manner stated in the Bonds.

**ARTICLE
REDEMPTION PROVISIONS**

SECTION Non-Callable. The Bonds are not callable for redemption prior to their stated dates of maturity.

**ARTICLE
APPLICATION OF BOND PROCEEDS**

SECTION Application of Bond Proceeds. As a condition of the issuance of the Bonds, the Issuer hereby binds and obligates itself to:

Apply a sufficient amount of the proceeds derived from the issuance and sale of the Bonds, together with additional moneys of the Issuer, if so required, from the sinking fund heretofore established and maintained for the payment of principal and interest on the Refunded Bonds, as will enable the Issuer to immediately redeem the Refunded Bonds in principal and accrued interest on the date set for the redemption of the Refunded Bonds.

Retain such amount of the proceeds of the Bonds and/or other moneys available to the Issuer from said sinking fund as will enable the Issuer to pay the Costs of Issuance of the Bonds.

**ARTICLE
TAX AND SECURITIES LAWS COVENANTS**

SECTION Tax Covenants. The Issuer covenants and agrees that, to the extent permitted by the laws of the State of Louisiana, it will comply with the requirements of the Code in order to establish, maintain and preserve the exclusion from Agross income@ of interest on the Bonds under the Code. The Issuer shall not take any action or fail to take any action, nor shall it permit at any time or times any of the proceeds of the Bonds or any other funds of the Issuer to be used directly or indirectly in any manner, to acquire any securities or obligations the acquisition of which would cause any Bond to be an Arbitrage bond@ as defined in the Code or would result in the inclusion of the interest on any Bond in Agross income@ under the Code, including, without limitation, (i) the failure to comply with the limitation on investment of the proceeds of the Bonds, (ii) the failure to pay any required rebate of arbitrage earnings to the United States of America, or (iii) the use of the proceeds of the Bonds in a manner which would cause the Bonds to be Aprivate activity bonds@ under the Code.

The Executive Officers are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to take any and all action and to execute and deliver any instrument, document or certificate necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Section.

SECTION Bonds are ABank-Qualified@. The Bonds are designated as Aqualified tax-exempt obligations@ within the meaning of Section 265(b)(3) of the Code. In making this designation, the Issuer finds and determines that:

(a) The Bonds are not Aprivate activity bonds@ within the meaning of the Code; and

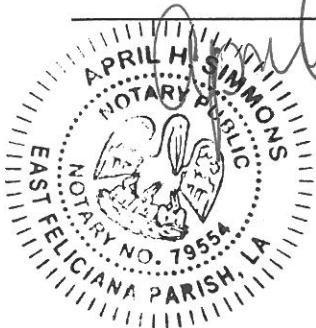
